SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To help us get to know you and your work, please send us:

- An artist statement describing your practice, specialized areas of interest and/or a particular body of work.
- A resume that includes your background (professional and photographic), training and exhibition/gallery experience (if any).
- Contact information (mail, email, telephone, website, etc).
- Examples of your work: 10 20 images; exhibition quality prints (unframed) to give us a sense of the subjects and themes you've been pursuing.
- Self-addressed stamped envelope for return of smaller submission packages. Otherwise, portfolios may be picked up in person during Gallery hours after membership decisions have been made.

Please note:

All prospective members must be willing to become an active participant in the co-operative framework and to commit to membership for one full year.

Submissions:

- Submissions may be left at ViewPoint Gallery, 109 -1475 Bedford Highway, Bedford. Gallery hours are Thursday Sunday 12 noon 5pm.
- Submissions should indicate: New Member Submission
- Portfolios will be reviewed within one month and responses will be in writing.
